Make-up day (if needed) for major co-curricular dismissal:

First Priority: If calamity day use is not exhausted – use calamity make-up day schedule.

Second Priority: If more than 3 calamity days have been used and a major co-curricular activity dismissal occurs, the make-up day for dismissal will be the next in order of make-up days on the order of utilization list.
